More good feelings center around international relationships that have grown sweeter over the years.

Sharing in our delight are our Iron Men and Iron Ladies, who faithfully pray for our counterparts in India, Nepal and the Philippines, not to mention holding each other up before the Lord. Also in our ministry support category are the many of you who pray often for us. Some listen to and promote our devotioncast, while others enjoy praying through our newsletters. Each one is a blessing to us and helps us do what we do, all for the glory of the Lord.

Many of you know that I do not wish to ask for donations, leaving those decisions to you who have seen and heard what God is doing and what the needs are, as shared in our letters. We are, however, asking God for His good provision, and I feel that it is important to let you know what some of the pressing needs really are. Perhaps God will move in some hearts to share in the blessings of generously supporting the work. The end of year giving opportunity is certainly upon us, and here are some needs that will turn into blessings, as donations make their way to us:

INDIA - Pastor Prem's orphanage project is ongoing, but the girls could all use dresses for Christmas. As always, there is constant need for food and the usual needs of children.

NEPAL - Umesh Pandit's family is still needing personal help with food & shelter after losing their home to the earthquakes. Their outreach to poor children and orphans needs almost total funding, but the organization is in place. Monthly commitment: \$100.00 Outreach goals, several thousand dollars / year.

- Susma Pandit will be joining us here in Pueblo soon. She will be adding to her educational portfolio before going back to work with Nepal's poor & orphaned children. We are sponsoring her trip & educational needs. Unmet school expenses will be \$16,000.00 for 2017 (from general fund).

PHILIPPINES - Bishnu & Goma Budhthapa are finishing seminary training and plan to return to Nepal in 2017, bringing a GraceMode presence to their home land. Their needs are ongoing, including living expenses while in school this last several months. We would love to be able to send them two to five hundred dollars per month, but they are working on their donor connections. Their regular support budget is not yet established for their work in Nepal.

HOME FRONT - Our General Fund covers everything that is not specially designated as projects. This includes office supplies, postage, Internet & phone service, Susma's trip & educational needs and other fees, travel and much more. Because our income is unpredictable, our budget is somewhat uncertain. Needs: \$2,000.00/month.
