Dear friends of Grace Mode, **October/November 2019**

In our last newsletter, We looked at the GraceMode family of missionaries and ministry partners , hoping to challenge all of our readers to pray for the work being done in Asia, Africa and here in Colorado. We also introduced our readers to the concept of taking a more personal relationship on, becoming a personal "champion" for one or more of our workers or projects, which could add a financial aspect to the prayer side of being there for our people. For the last several months, God has been doing wonderful things through our ministries, despite a profound lack of financial support. GraceMode donations have gone down dramatically, but the commitment of our workers has remained the same, if not become stronger.

Our financial policy is simple: **We ask God, and we tell His people the ministry needs.** We will not beg, unless we are only speaking to God in prayer.

In today's letter, we hope to highlight what God is doing, although many day by day ministry opportunities are not captured in photos or called to our attention with words. Some of what happens on a regular basis is too sensitive for us to share and could put our workers at risk. God knows all of the needs, and He is our provider! We want you to know the needs, so that if God tugs on your heart, you will know what He is trying to tell you. Honestly, we are content to leave your response in God's hands - between you and Him!

With each ministry, we will share roughly what the **monthly needs are with a dollar amount displayed in blue numbers.** In **red numbers**, you will also see an **estimated monthly shortfall** for that worker's support level. Some have been able to receive regular monthly amounts, while others have not been blessed by consistent (budgetable) support.

Again, please understand that we know that not all can give and that there are many worthy causes in need of support. Our bold plea is simple enough: **"Brethren, pray for us."** What goes on between you and God is personal, and private. May God bless you richly, our friends, family and fellow servants of the Most High God!

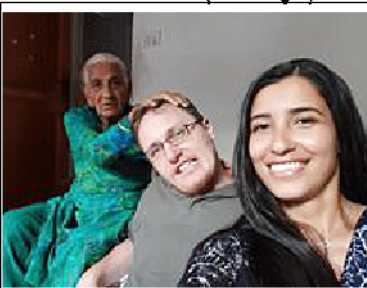


These blurred faces* were all smiles last Christmas, as Bishnu brought gifts and a clear picture of what Christmas is all about to a remote village in Jumla.

This is a major commitment, and much funding is needed, but we are depending on God's people to be champions for the villagers and for the workers again this year.

Bishnu does leadership training throughout the year in the Jumla area. This is also bringing fruit to the ministry. His budget is outdated now. We have been able to keep up with the old budget, but that did not include the many trips or the special Christmas projects.
