Dear friends of GraceMode,

God continues to move in our midst, no matter what comes! No pandemic, government, law, obstacles, or threats can stop God from using His children to fulfill the Great Commission! With God, not one thing is impossible.

Our ministry is relatively small and new. We are coming up on our 10th anniversary of becoming a recognized nonprofit. We operate on a "shoestring" budget, but God continues to use our missionaries and partners in ministry to do amazing things. Quietly, in countries where the Gospel is frowned upon, to put it mildly, we are seeing the beginnings of churches and groups of believers ready to praise our great God and share their faith in whatever ways they can. On the next page, I share a small percentage of what is happening *now*, as well as some of what these ten years have brought to us. Some tasks cannot be shared in order to protect both workers and those to whom we minister, but the truth is evident that God is in this work!

Before we move to those brief reports, I'd like to fill you in on our personal journey, as we serve the Lord here on the home front:

Eloise is still recovering from last year's knee replacement surgery. It was a success, but other issues have brought a lot of pain into the picture. We just found out that a major problem involves a cluster of pinched nerves in her back or spinal area. The *remedy* is on the way. She will undergo a procedure on May 7th, when she will get precision shot(s) to address that issue. Her doctors (a wonderful team) are doing all that they can to help her get back to pain free living. Her pain has affected both of us, of course, but we press on to continue serving our Lord and supporting our missionaries.

Together, Eloise and I prepare lessons for our Iron Men and our Iron Ladies Bible studies on Thursday mornings. Our time studying together had been lots of fun, blessing us in our relationship and strengthening our teaching and sharing.

I continue producing our "Moments of Grace" podcast, now in the 15th year. It is available on several podcasting platforms, and gaining listeners regularly. One Apple Music listener posted a comment that blessed us greatly, calling Moments of Grace a "hidden treasure". Bishnu and Goma were both born in Jumla, Nepal, and now their hearts are given to serving the Lord Jesus by reaching out to the unreached people of Jumla. Living near Kathmandu, Bishnu often travels to Jumla to help local believers reach out with the Gospel. Bishnu trains church leadership in outreach, evangelism, and discipleship. He also does an annual outreach to an unreached village high in the Himalayas, bringing much needed items, like shoes, jackets, blankets and gifts to the villagers, especially the children. He was even able to bring food to an entire village last year when the pandemic cut off all work & food supply. Every family is given the gospel, and some entire families are now believers, being followed up by a nearby local pastor. THREE YEARS - THREE VILLAGES!

On April 24, 2021, John and Esther welcomed their new (beautiful) daughter, Eloise Eliana, to their family!






Pastor Prem Raulo and his FAITH Ministries, Odisha, India, work with poor and needy children, widows and orphans.
