Training for Churches and Youth: We have several training programs planned for pastors and youth leaders from economically challenged backgrounds. We cover their materials, travel, lodging, and food, since many come from far and isolated regions and have no other regular Bible training available.

Himalayan Outreach Program: Starting this year, we are preparing to reach one of the unreached regions near the China border (see picture on the third column.). Our next outreach trip is scheduled for September. This is a significant step toward expanding the Kingdom in the Himalayan belt.

To carry forward all these ministry activities without financial hesitation, we are praying and trusting the Lord for a regular monthly provision of \$2,000.00, allowing us to faithfully continue the work He has entrusted to us.

We humbly bring this need before you and ask you to pray with us. If God prompts your heart, we invite you to partner with us. Your support—no matter the amount—will help change lives and communities for eternity.
