

Greetings to everyone from Nepal, November 20, 2019

We* hope you all are doing well, First of all we want to thank you for opening your hearts and hands for poor children in remote areas. As you know, we did a Christmas program last year, thanks to your support and prayers. Our hearts were warmed, as children received warm clothes and gifts, and an entire village heard of Jesus for the first time.



Again this year, we are prayerfully planning an outreach to another area of Nepal that is untouched by the Gospel. The place is named Patharkhola. This, too, is a remote area of Jumla, which is one of the most backward places in Nepal when it comes to any infrastructure. These people have been isolated, because they lack modern facilities. There is no electricity, and they must depend on firewood. Because of this, the poor economy, and the lack of health care providers, there are many health problems, and their situation is dismal, at best.



Patharkhola lies on very high altitude, making cultivation and harvesting time very short and insufficient for providing food for more than six months. Poverty and unemployment are the major problem for this place. Malnutrition is one of the common problem among the children. Every male in the family have to go to India or Arab countries to get the job.

The winter season has begun here in Nepal, and in November it is already freezing cold. To wear a warm jacket is like a dream of the children in this area. They must live with a single piece of torn cloth, the bitter reality of the Himalayan people.



Imagine - if we could provide each child a warm jacket during this Christmas season, this unexpected gift for them would be amazing, and it could open their hearts to the true message of the greatest gift of all, the coming of Jesus to provide the warmth of salvation. This Christmas we are praying to take this Christmas gift to these children, with our main goal being to penetrate hearts with the gospel, bringing the message of God's provision to people who have never heard about Christ. This is one way to show the

love of Christ and make him known.
